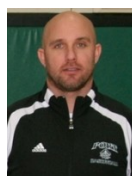
### SWIMMING & DIVE by Melissa Hoogester



It was another great meet for us against the Highlanders from Homestead. It began with the 'A' 200 medley team: Miller, Bischoff, Olson and DeMerit had a great second place with their time, 1:54.67. The 'B' team: Biskobing, Howell, Locke and Roller finished fourth with their time, 2:02.15. DeMerit (2:01.71 – a season best time for him!) had an awesome come from behind to win the 200 freestyle event! Biskobing (2:11.96) was right behind finishing fourth and Mehre (2:24.23) finished sixth place. Miller (2:20.23 – just hundredths off his personal best time) had a great second place in the 200 IM followed by Olson (2:25.26) finishing fifth and Bischoff (2:38.80) finishing sixth place. Roller had a great second place finish in the 50 freestyle with Kasdorf (27.39 – just hundredths off his personal best time) right behind finishing fourth and Howell (27.50 – just hundredths off his personal best time) finishing fifth place. C. Theis (1:57.85) and Schmidt (1:27.15) had a great night of diving finishing first and second places! Olson (1:00.57 – just hundredths off his personal best time) finished an awesome second place in the 100 butterfly with Biskobing (1:08.12) finishing fifth and Mehre (1:16.18 – a personal best time for him!) finishing sixth place. Huebner (1:00.24 – a personal best time for him!) had a great third place finish in the 100 freestyle with Kasdorf (1:03.47 – just hundredths

off his personal best time) finishing fourth and Tumey (1:05.83 57 – just hundredths off his personal best time) finishing sixth. DeMerit (5:34.33 – a season best time for him!) did not disappoint again with his second first place finish of the evening in the 500 freestyle. Locke (6:10.13 – a personal best time for him!) and Sharbuno (6:22.54 – a personal best time for him!) both also swam great 500 freestyle races; Locke finished fourth and Sharbuno fifth place! The 200 freestyle 'A' team: Roller, Howell, Kasdorf and Biskobing finished third with their best time, 1:45.15! The 'B' team: Huebner, Hadacek, DeMaria, and Mehre finishing fourth with their time, 1:52.28. Miller (1:01.58 – just hundredths off his personal best time) had an awesome first place finish in the 100 backstroke for his team! Roller (1:16.67) and Locke (1:19.65) both also swam the backstroke finishing fourth and fifth places. Bischoff (1:18.49) finished third place in the 100 breaststroke followed by Hadacek (1:23.13 – a personal best time for him!) finished fifth and DeMaria (1:27.53 13 – a personal best time for him!) finished sixth place. Last up was the 400 freestyle relay event. The 'A' team: Olson, Bischoff, Miller and DeMerit finished third place with their time, 3:47.37 and the 'B' team: Kasdorf, Tumey, Huebner and Locke finished fourth with their time, 4:16.20. It was a great meet for the guys; thought we didn't come away with a win, we finished much better than we did last year. Onto Kiel on Tuesday!

The Port gymnasts did a nice job in a very difficult field at the Waterford Invitational. In February, Waterford will host sectionals, and Port should have the exact same rotation it had on Saturday. What will be very different is the competition. Kenosha Combined (Kenosha Tremper, Kenosha Bradford, and Kenosha Indian Trail) won the meet with a 146.275. That's two points higher than the D2 state record. Brookfield East/Central was second and Franklin/Oak Creek/Muskego/Whitnall was third. All three of those teams finished in the top 4 at D1 state last year. Port was a ways behind at 115.1, but the day was not without highlights!

The top placer for Port was Carmen Hoag who finished 13th in the All-around competition. She also had a milestone first ever score over 8.0 with her 8.025 on floor. Carmen has had a ton of high 7s over the past few years, but it was really nice to see her finally reach this milestone. The top individual event finish for Port was Kaylyn Garant in 16th on floor with a 9.05. This is a personal best for her, and as she is already the school record holder on the event, a new school record.

When the Pirates next return to Waterford at the end of the season to face a field of D2 teams, we are hoping all the added difficulty in routines will lead to a better team score, and hopefully some state-qualifying top 5 finishes!

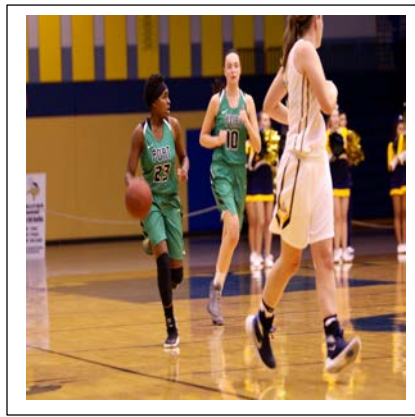
