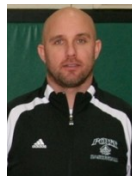
January 16, 2016 Manitowoc Invite

The Manti Invite is always an enjoyable invite for the guys to attend! We are able to swim against teams we only see at the invite, which is fun! And this is always an AWESOME meet for the guys!!! The afternoon began with the 200 Medley Relay; 'A' team: Miller, Schanen, Olson, and DeMerit finished seventh place with their best time 1:55.82 followed by the 'B' team: Biskobing, S. Patterson, Locke, and Tyree who finished ninth place with their time 2:00.84! Tyree (2:05.69 – a season best time!) finished twelfth followed by Biskobing (2:08.85 – a personal best time by 2 seconds!) finishing fifteenth and Walch (2:12.13 – a season best time!) finishing eighteenth place, Roller (2:17.32 – a personal best time by 8 seconds!) and J. DeMaria (2:18.90 – a personal best time by 4 seconds!) all in the 200 Freestyle! Miller (2:31.24) finished sixteenth in the 200 IM! DeMerit had a top sixteen finish for his team, finishing seventh place, just missing the awards podium by four one-hundredths of a second with his time, 24.66! Olson (26.07 – a personal best time!) also finished in the top sixteen with his fifteenth

finish both in the 50 Freestyle! Olson had another top sixteen finish, he finished fourteen in the 100 Butterfly with his personal best time, 1:05.60! DeMerit had another top sixteen finish for his team, just missing the awards podium again this time by one one-hundredths of a second, finishing seventh place in the 100 Freestyle with his time 54.28! Tyree earned a top sixteenth place finish, finishing eighth, in the 500 Freestyle with this time 5:48.73 followed by Toal also earning a top sixteen finish, finishing fifteenth with his time, 6:07.65! Both 200 Freestyle Relay teams finished in the top sixteen, the 'A' relay: DeMerit, Tyree, Olson and Miller finished an awesome awards podium sixth place with their time 1:41.48 followed by the 'B' relay: Walch, Bischoff, Roller and Biskobing finishing an awesome eleventh place with their time 1:47.70! Miller (1:04.60 – a personal best by 2 seconds!) wanted another medal, and he knew exactly what he needed to do for it. He had an outstanding fourth place finish in the 100 Backstroke! Biskobing (1:08.86 – a personal best time by 2 seconds!) also finished in the top sixteen; he finished eighth place and J. DeMaria (1:11.36 – a personal best time by 4 seconds!) also finished in the top sixteen, he finished twelfth place! Backstroke was an awesome event for us!! Breaststroke was also a great event for us! Schanen had a great seventh place finish, just missing the awards podium, in the 100 Breaststroke with his season best time, 1:13.70! S. Patterson (1:16.10 – personal best time by 3 seconds!) also finished in the top sixteen, he finished twelfth place! Our 400 Freestyle 'B' Relay team: Locke, Norman, Schanen and Walch finished in the top sixteen, they finished tenth place, with their best time, 4:05.21! Another AWESOME meet for the guys; we had awesome times, lots of fun, came away with some hardware and another way to swim against great talent!

The Port Gymnasts defeated D2 competitor Shorewood 123.375-112.20. The Pirates were led by strong performances from Kaylyn

Garant, who won the all-around competition with a 32.525 and Dani O'Donnell who was second all-around with a 32.2. Kaylyn was first on floor and beam. Dani was first on vault. The two tied for first on bars. Kylee Paradowski and Hailey Brakke rounded out the varsity scoring for Port with all-around scores of 29.35 and 29.3 respectively.

At the JV level, Port also dominated the meet, winning 95.45 to 69.85. The competition was very close within our team. Carmen Hoag was the all-around winner with a score of 25.7. Claudia Weyker was right behind her with a 25.45, and Daytona Snook finished 3rd with a 24.5. That trio also went 1-2-3 on vault and floor and took two of the top three spots on bars and beam, where falls prevented them from completing the sweep.

It was nice to get a win against a team who usually places within a spot or two of us at sectionals. The girls looked good, and it was nice to see some of the depth stepping up from the JV level.
