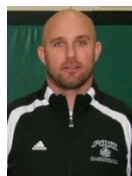

WOW what a meet last night! It literally came down to the last relay of the evening! We could not quite sneak it out, but it was a well fought meet for sure! The evening began with an awesome first place win by the 'A' 200 medley relay team: Miller, Bischoff, Olson and DeMerit with their best time, 1:51.01! The 'B' 200 medley relay team: Biskobing, Howell, Locke and Roller were right behind finishing third place with their best time by 2 seconds, 1:59.79! Roller (2:14.09 – a season best time for him by 8 seconds!) finished an awesome third place in the 200 freestyle, followed by Huegerich (2:16.35 – a personal best time for him by 10 seconds!) finished right behind in fourth place and Sharbuno (2:17.86 – a personal best time for him by 3 seconds!) right behind finishing fifth place! Miller (2:18.79 – a personal best time for him by 1 second!) had an outstanding race in the 200 IM finishing first, with Mehre (2:33.87 – a personal best time for him by 21 seconds!) finished fourth and DeMaria (2:39.93 – a personal best time for him by 3 seconds!) finished fifth place. DeMerit (24.19 – a personal best time for him!) had a great second place finish in the 50 freestyle with Biskobing (25.16 – a personal best time for him!) finished fourth and Bischoff (27.15) finished sixth place. Our divers, J. Theis (202.30 –

a personal best score for him!) earned first place, C. Theis (177.75) finished second and Schmidt (164.50 – a personal best score for him!) earned third place for their team adding points to our score; great diving guys! Olson (59.83 – just hundredths off his personal best) finished an awesome second place, Biskobing (1:02.69 – a personal best time for him!) had a great third place finish just out-touching his opponent, and Locke (1:08.75 – a season best time for him by 2 seconds!) finished sixth place. DeMerit (54.28) had another awesome second place finish in the 100 freestyle, followed by Howell (1:01.10 – just hundredths off his personal best) finished fourth and Huegerich (1:03.35 – a personal best time for him by a second!) finished fifth place. Sharbuno (6:07.18 – a personal best time for him by 7 seconds!) swam an outstanding 500 freestyle race! He finished second place, Meier (6:31.33 – a personal best time for him by 16 seconds!) finished fifth and Huebner (7:14.93 – a personal best time for him by 55 seconds!) finished sixth place. Our 200 'A' free relay: Olson, Miller, Biskobing, and DeMerit were just out-touched by 34 one-hundredths for first, their best time was 1:38.99! The 'B' free relay: DeMaria, Huebner, Mehre, and Huegerich finished fourth with their time, 1:51.17! Miller (59.46 – a personal best time for him!) had an awesome first place finish in the 100 backstroke! Roller (1:12.07) was just behind finishing third place and Tumey (1:13.33 – a personal best time for him!) finished sixth place. Olson (1:11.10) came out of nowhere to crush the 100 breaststroke race! He finished first place in this awesome race! Bischoff (1:15.06) right behind finishing second and Locke (1:29.65 – a personal best time for him!) finished fifth place. As I said before, it all came down to this last race... the 'A' 400 relay: Huegerich, Roller, DeMaria, and Bischoff finished second place and our 'B' relay: Huebner, Howell, Mehre and Locke finished fourth, just being out-touched by .04 seconds. Despite the loss, it was our best meet of the season by far! A ton of best times, and more importantly tons of fun! Onto the Small School Invite tomorrow!

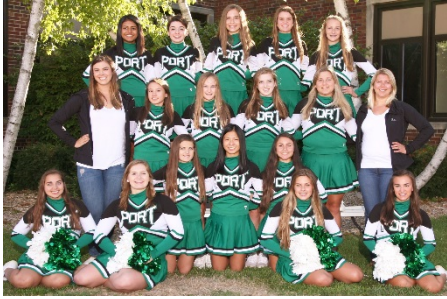
MILWAUKEE LUTHERAN: 60

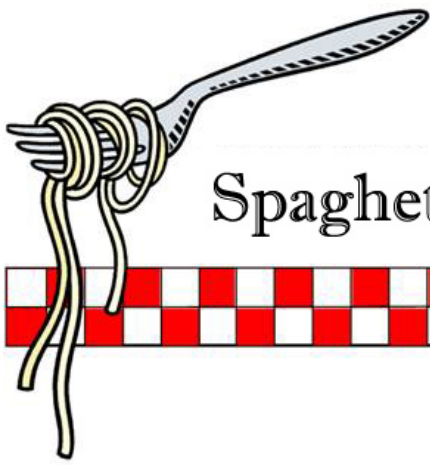
