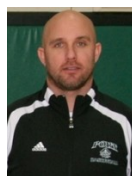


January 30, 2016 Eastern Regional

Our last dual meet at home was against the co-op teams of Brillion/Valders/Chilton. It was an awesome way to end our dual meets at home and an even better way to honor our Seniors with a WIN!

The evening began with the 200 Medley relay 'A' team: Miller, Schanen, Olson and DeMerit finishing an awesome first place with their time, 1:57.20! The 'B' team: Biskobing, S. Patterson, Locke and Tyree were right behind finishing second place with their time, 2:02.13! Tyree (2:06.63), Biskobing (2:05.99 – a personal best by 3 seconds!) and Olson (2:09.34 – a personal best by a second!) were up for the 200 Freestyle and all swam awesome races! Biskobing finished and awesome second place, Tyree finished an exciting third and Olson finished right behind in fourth place! DeMerit (2:22.60 – a personal best!), Miller (2:28.67) and Schanen (2:35.90) all swam the 200 IM last night, and great races they swam! DeMerit finished and awesome first, followed by Miller finishing second place and Schanen finished fifth. Walch (26.94), Roller (27.35) and Locke (27.53 – a personal best!) all wanted to give the 50 Freestyle 'a go' last night and it was an awesome race! Walch

finished fourth, Roller finished fifth and Locke finished sixth.

Up next were the brave souls who swim the 100 Butterfly; Olson, Locke and Bischoff. All three had great finishes; Olson (1:05.69) finished an awesome second place, Locke (1:09.87) finished third and Bischoff (1:12.71) finished fourth, a 2-3-4 sweep in the fly! Walch (59.31 – a best time!), Norman (59.69) and Roller (1:00.69 – a personal best!) swam the other sprint event last night, the 100 Freestyle. A great race by all three guys; Walch finished third, Norman finished fourth and Roller finished fifth places.

Up next the longest event of the evening, the 500 Freestyle, was swum by DeMerit (5:28.94 – a personal best!), Tyree (5:51.41) and Toal (5:53.33 – a personal best!). Another great race! DeMerit finished an awesome second place, Tyree finished a great third place, and Toal finished and awesome fourth place. Toal has wanted to go under 6 minutes in the 500 free, and last night he did it!

The 200 Freestyle 'A' team: Biskobing, Bischoff, Toal and Walch had a great second place finish with their time, 1:48.37. The 'B' team: Norman, Roller, Schanen, and Locke also had a great fourth place finish with their time, 1:49.15.

Miller (1:04.83), Biskobing (1:10.30), and Norman (1:13.68) were up next for the 100 Backstroke. A great race for all three! Miller finished an awesome first place, Biskobing finished a great third, and Norman was right behind finishing fourth place!

The last individual event of the evening, the 100 Breaststroke, swam by Schanen (1:13.87), S. Patterson (1:17.41) and Bischoff (1:23.00) was an awesome race! We went 1-2-4;

Schanen finished first place, S. Patterson finished second place, and Bischoff finished fourth place!

The last event of the evening was definitely exciting! We had a feeling it would come down to this race! The 400 Freestyle 'A' team: DeMerit, Miller, Olson and Tyree had a great second place finish with their best time, 3:43.96! The 'B' team: Toal, Norman, Bischoff, and Walch also had a great third place finish with their time, 4:07.68. And that sealed the WIN for us!!!!!!

Our last dual meet of the season was a great meet, with a ton of best times!

The evening began with the 200 Medley relay teams: 'A' Miller, Schanen, DeMerit and Olson finishing first place with their best time, 1:54.98 and the 'B' team: Biskobing, S. Patterson, Locke and Tyree finishing third place with their time, 2:01.24!

The 200 Freestyle was swum by: Tyree (2:05.65 – a personal best!), Biskobing (2:05.95 – a personal best!) and Toal (2:13.54). Tyree finished third place, Biskobing finished fourth place and Toal finished fifth place.

It was another 3-4-5 finish for us in the 200 IM race. Miller (2:29.82) finished third place, Schanen (2:31.77 – a season best!) finished

fourth place and Norman (2:34.36 – a personal best) finished fifth place.

In the 50 Freestyle; DeMerit (24.22 – a personal best!) finished second, Roller (26.83 – a personal best!) finished fifth and Locke (27.88) finished sixth place.

In the 100 Butterfly, all three guys had best times! Olson (1:04.20) finished third place, Locke (1:08.59) finished fifth place and Bischoff (1:09.50) finished sixth place!

DeMerit had a second place finish and was just out-touched in the 50 Freestyle and he wasn't going to let that happen in the 100 Freestyle! He finished first with his personal best time (54.54) followed by Roller, so close to breaking a minute, (1:00.04 – a personal best!) finished fourth place and D. DeMaria (1:03.21) finished fifth place.

Tyree has wanted to break his best 500 Freestyle time from last year, 5:43.13 and this was his night! He finished third place with his new personal best time, 5:41.48! Toal (5:58.25) also had a great swim in the 500 free, he finished fourth place followed by Olson (6:04.98) finishing sixth place.

Biskobing, Bischoff, D. DeMaria and Toal were the 'A' 200 Freestyle relay team. They finished fourth place with their time, 1:48.22 followed by Norman, Roller, Schanen and Locke finishing fifth place with their time, 1:50.58.

Miller, who has been really devoted to working hard this season, especially on his backstroke had an awesome first place finish with his personal best time 1:03.82! Biskobing (1:10.31) finished third and Norman (1:12.43) finished fifth place in the 100 Backstroke. Schanen (1:14.11) finished second place, S. Patterson (1:19.19) finished fifth place and Bischoff (1:20.67) finished sixth place all in the 100 Breaststroke.

Congratulations Amanda Baierl – Journal Sentinel Player of the Week!

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Amanda Baierl, Port Washington. It's been a year of streaks for the Pirates, who opened the season with four straight losses followed by four straight victories. Last week Baierl, a 6-foot junior forward, helped the team snap a six-game skid and win twice.

She scored a season-high 28 points on 12-of-17 shooting, grabbed 17 rebounds and blocked five shots in a 64-54 victory at Sheboygan South on Jan. 25. On Friday she went 9 of 12 from the floor on the way to a 20-point, nine-rebound, two-block effort in a 62-36 victory over Milwaukee Lutheran.

Baierl leads Port in scoring with 17.8 points per game.

"She has a great work ethic that allows her to be successful as we have gone through the course of the season," Pirates coach Jakob Wahl said via email. "Amanda has been a consistent scorer for us, but her value to our team can be seen on the defensive side of the court."
