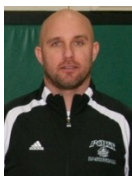

The Ice Hawks came home from Madison with a convincing victory, downing the Madison East/La Follette Lakers by a score of 6-1.

The Ice Hawks opened the scoring just over 8 minutes into the first period when Nate Perez (Grafton) fed Taylor Snider (Port Washington) with a slick pass from behind the net. Snider made no mistake, firing home his first of the game. Shortly thereafter, the Ice Hawks were up 2-0 after Ian Schermer (Grafton) finished off a rebounded shot from Max Manz (Grafton) on the power play. The Ice Hawks then added a third as Captain Bryce Fisk (Grafton) took and buried a penalty shot.

The Lakers started the second period strong, and after some extended pressure, were able to put one home to draw the game closer at 3-1. However, the Ice Hawks responded two minutes later when Nate Burnside (Living Word) put home a chance assisted by Danny Likins (Grafton). The Ice Hawks added a fifth through Snider with just over a minute left in the second to take a 5-1 lead into the third.

At the start of the third, Ty Barnhill (Port Washington) relieved Izac Hickcox (Grafton) in net, who eventually would earn the win with 17 saves on 18 shots. After the sixth and final Ice Hawks goal courtesy of Danny Likins, Barnhill would close out the game by stopping all six shots he faced.
