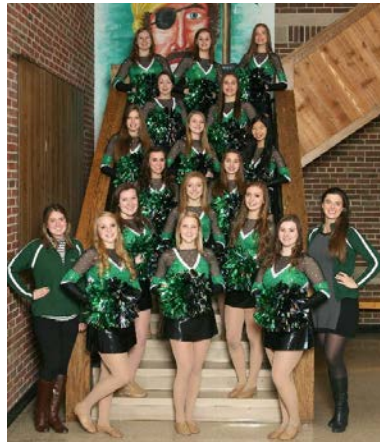

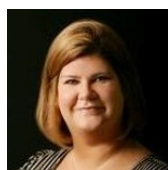
In the second, the teams exchanged goals. Germantown first tied it up with

However, the Ice Hawks continued their pressure and were rewarded just under four minutes last as Snider tucked one home on the helper from Perez. The 2-1 lead would hold into the third, when Germantown was able to even the score on a 4-3 power play advantage. As the play wound down, both teams showed exceptional grit, and an additional 8 minutes of overtime - with plenty of end-to-end action - didn't produce a winner. In the end, the scoreboard read 2-2 with the honors evenly split. Goalie Izac Hickcox (Grafton) put in a great performance, stopping 39 of 41 shots on the day.

With the result, the Ice Hawks earned their highest ever point total in the North Shore Conference (4), finishing in fourth with a 1-5-2 record. Overall, the team completed the regular season at 12-8-2, the program's best since 2010-2011.

Next up for the Ice Hawks is the WIAA Playoffs. Having been seeded at #12 in Section 8, the Ice Hawks will "visit" #5 Homestead on Tuesday, February 17. The puck will drop at 7 PM on the South Rink of the Ozaukee Ice Center.

The exciting day began with the 200 Medley Relay team: Nosko, Schanen, LaCosse and DeMerit finishing fourth place, earning a spot on the awards' podium with their 2 second PR time 1:54.51!



Tyree(2:03.86 – a four second PR!) and Walch (2:07.96 – a five second PR!) swam the 200 Freestyle for their team finishing eleventh and thirteenth places. Schanen (2:26.45 – a six second PR!) and Noll (2:33.60 – a one second PR!) swam AWESOME races in the 200 IM. Schanen was able to stand upon the awards podium for his sixth place finishing, definitely a proud moment for him and me! DeMerit (24.99) finished ninth place in the 50 Freestyle. LaCosse (1:02.88 – a three second PR!) swam the 100

Butterfly finishing ninth place! DeMerit (55.08) swam the 100 Freestyle for his team, along with Walch (59.14) and Miller (1:01.44). DeMerit had a ninth place finish in the 100 Freestyle. Nosko finished third place at Sectionals with his 10 second PR time of 5:07.57 in the 500 Freestyle!! I. Tyree also swam the 500 Freestyle finishing eighth place for his team with his 7 second PR drop 5:43.13! The 200 Freestyle Relay team: Biskobing, Noll, Schanen and Walch finished ninth place for their team with their time 1:47.60. Nosko stood on the awards podium a second time for his awesome 100 Backstroke swim finishing fourth place with his PR time of 1:02.02!



Followed by Noll (1:08.27 – a one second PR! Finishing seventh place and Biskobing (1:11.66) finishing ninth place! Schanen in the 100 Breaststroke, dropped 3 seconds earning an eighth place finish with his time 1:12.77! LaCosse (1:14.69 – a 3 second PR drop!) finished ninth just behind his team mate Schanen! The 400 Freestyle Relay team: Nosko, Olson, Tyree, DeMerit had an extremely exciting finish fifth place overall with their time 3:45.65.
