The girls put together a strong night on Friday at the Conference meet. They were 6th with a 128.8. Homestead was 5th at 133.375, and Shorewood 7th at 121.15. The champions were Brookfield Combined with a 143.875.

Each of the Pirates' team event scores were in the top four of what they've done this season and bars and floor were the very best! On bars, the improvement was carried by Dani O'Donnell who finally took the school record on bars with an 8.7. She was 5th in Conference, which is no small feat with the current group. All four of the girls who beat her have won medals at state, and she beat out last year's 7th, 9th, and 11th place state finishers for bars.

The Port gymnasts also put in their best group performance of the year on floor with a 34.2. Hailey Brakke went first and scored a 7.8--only .05 off her season best. Kylee Paradowski tied her best with an 8.8. Dani O'Donnell improved her career best with an 8.9, and Kaylyn Garant added a very solid 8.7.

Freshman Julia Greisch also deserves a nod for her 3rd place finish on JV beam of 7.6! Congratulations to all the girls, and good luck this Friday at Sectionals!
