February 26, 2015 vs Germantown

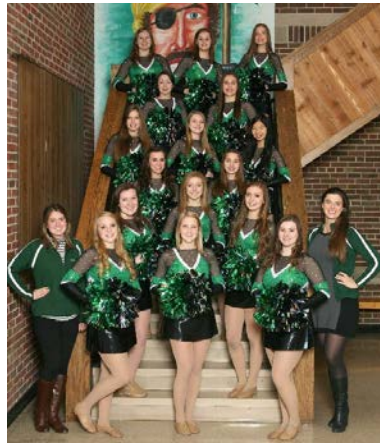
