The boys traveled to Milwaukee Lutheran High School on Saturday 3/25 to participate in the Chris Wilson Invitational. It was a 6 team invitational which was an indoor meet which was contested in Lutheran's beautiful field house. The boys ended up in 2nd place with 79 points to host Lutheran who tallied 106 points. Nick Landowski had a great day. He won the high jump, long jump and 55 meter high hurdles. He was also a member of the 4 x 1 lap relay team with Devon Green, Anthony Masters and Nathan Russell which ended up in 3rd place. All together Nick contributed 36 points to the teams total of 79. Green and Masters also placed 4th and 5th respectively in the 55 meter dash. Masters then came back and ended up in 5th place in the 200 meter dash. Charles DeMerit finished in 4th place in the 3200 meter run. The next meet for the boys is the Madison West Relays hosted at the University of Wisconsin's Camp Randal Field House on Saturday 4/1.
