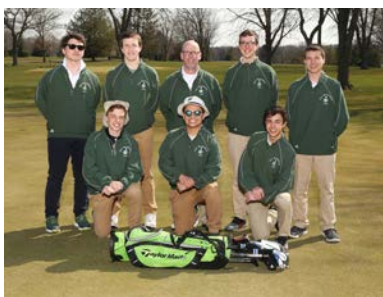

Brianna Heinen. She pitched well in her 1st start of the year. The Pirates took a 5-1 loss.

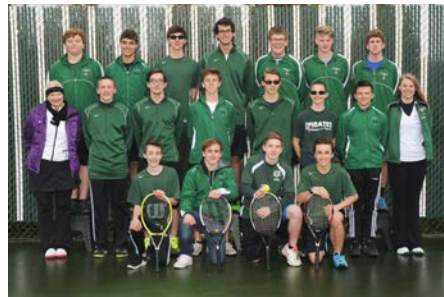
### **April 16, 2016 vs Fond du Lac Port Washington 1 Fond du Lac 9**
