Kewaskum 2**

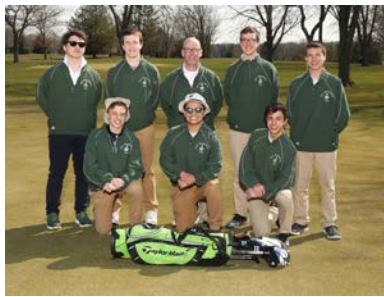
