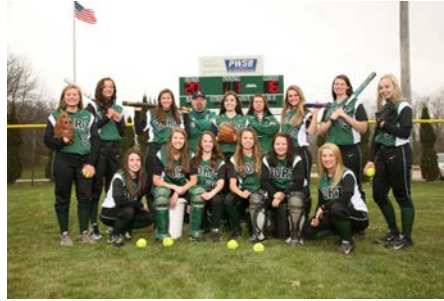
The Pirates visited Kettle Moraine
