The boys finished in 8th place at the North Shore Conference Championship on Tuesday at Nicolet High School. The Pirates earned 41 points in the meet which was won by Whitefish Bay with 148 points. The top performances were turned in by: Nick Bath 3rd in the 1600 meter run with a personal best time of 4:30.64. Nick also finished in 5th place in the 3200 with a time of 10:02.12. He was closely followed by Ben Class who finished in 6th place with a personal best time of 10:18.65. Nolan Olson finished in 6th place in the 300 meter hurdles with a personal best time of 42.73. Anthony Masters finished in 7th place in the 400 meter dash with a time of 54.3. The 4 x 800 meter relay of Max Noll, Nolan, Zach Wehner and JT Kasdorf finished in 4th place. The 4 x 400 meter relay of Eli Olson, Nolan, Zach Wehner and Anthony Masters finished in 5th place. In the field events Nick Landowski tied for 4th place in the high jump with a leap of 5'8". Nick also finished in 6th place in the long jump with a leap of 19'6.5". Michael Murphy came in 5th place in the pole vault with a personal best of 12'. He was followed by Sam Fritsch who came in 8th place with at vault of 11'. Kyle Casasola continued his strong season in the discus with a throw of 134'6" which was good enough for 4th place.

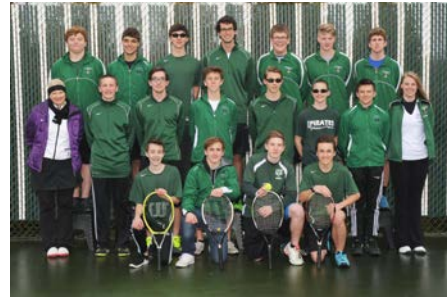

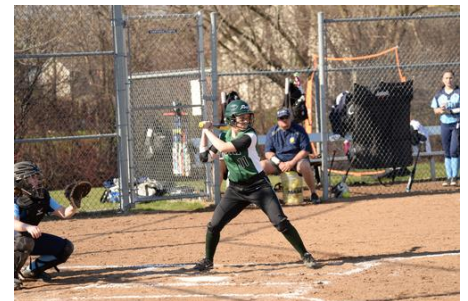
