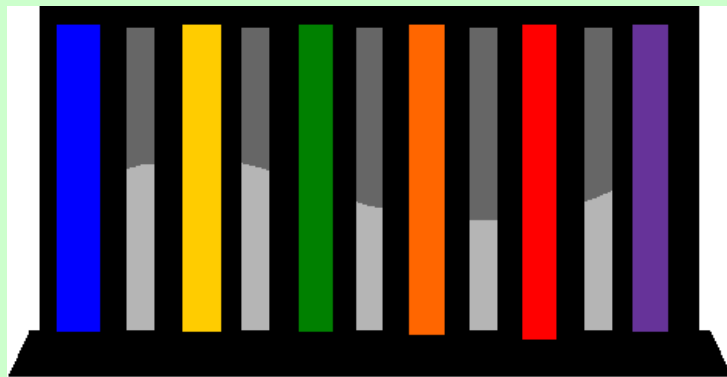

Nick Bath had an outstanding race and finished in 16th place with a personal best time of 17:25. Our second meet on the road and first dual meet against Sheboygan North was a great meet! The evening began with Klassen, Ottesen, a Stieg and Sharbuno on the 'A' 200 Medley relay finishing third place with their time, 2:16.66 followed by the 'B' relay: Grady, Singletary, Orvis, and Wichmann finishing fifth place with their time, 2:33.44. Orvis (2:32.96) had an awesome race and came from behind to finish third place followed by a Stieg (2:38.02), and Wichmann (2:53.94) swam the 200 Freestyle and all had great swims! Sharbuno (2:26.00), finished an exciting first place and Singletary (3:23.68), finished fifth place, swimming the 200 IM and both had great times. Hoag (54.70) had an awesome swim in the 50 Freestyle for her team! Ottesen (28.31) and Grady (33.41) swam the 50 Freestyle for the first time this season and finished second and fifth places. a Steig (1:35.54) and Marinez (1:49.10) were the brave girls who swam the 100 Butterfly for their team. They both swam great races finishing fourth and fifth places. Hoag (1:57.66) also swam the 100 Freestyle for her team and had an outstanding race! Klassen (1:10.76), Wichmann (1:17.73) and Cook (1:26.70) all swam great in the

100 Freestyle finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places. Grady and Orvis swam the dreaded 500 Freestyle for their team and I was thrilled with both their performances! Grady finished a solid second place with her time, 6:49.21 and Orvis finished an awesome third place with her time, 6:56.44! It was a great meet with awesome swims and we hadn't swum against Sheboygan North before, so it was a great experience and a great team to go up against!
