Our dual meet against Cedarburg was held at home. The girls had the opportunity to mix things up a bit, we switched around the strokes they normally swim, and gave them a chance to swim something else. It was a fun meet! The evening began with the 200 Medley relay swum by Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis finishing fourth place with their time 2:13.31. Grady, a Steig, McBride, and Wichmann also swam the 200 Medley finishing fourth place for their team. Ottesen (2:14.05) had an awesome race in the 200

Freestyle and out touched her opponent for a second place finish with her time, 2:14.05, she did great! Wichmann (2:46.96) and Cook (3:03.87) also swam the 200 Freestyle both with great races! Klassen (2:41.40), Grady (3:13.70) and Marinez (3:36.67) all swam the 200 IM finishing an exciting fourth for Klassen, fifth for Grady and sixth for Marinez! Hoag swam an outstanding race in the 50 Freestyle, bettering her time by three seconds, 51.30! Orvis (31.49) Singletary (33.67) and Pfeifauf (38.76) swam the 50 Freestyle for their team finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places! Sharbuno (1:07.14) finished an exciting second, Ottesen (1:15.33) finished an exciting fourth, and McBride (1:37.38) finished sixth place all swam the 100 Butterfly. The 100 Freestyle event was swum by Grady who had a great time, 1:09.35 and finished fourth, a Steig also had a great time, 1:11.44, finished fifth place and Marinez (1:26.48) also swam great with her time, 1:26.48 and finished sixth. Klassen (7:02.05), Wichmann (7:26.85) and Singletary (7:49.42) bravely swam the 500 Freestyle last night for the first time this season and they all did great finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places! Grady, McBride, a Steig and Wichman were the 'A,' 200 Freestyle relay team and they finished third place with their time, 2:13.42. The 'B' team: Cook Marinez, Pfeifauf, and Singletary were not far behind finishing fourth place with their time, 2:28.73! Hoag (2:05.88) dropped two seconds in her 100 Backstroke and also out touched a girl, a very exciting race indeed! The 100 Backstroke was also swum by Orvis (1:24.70) who finished fourth, a Steig (1:35.48) who finished fifth and Pfeifauf (1:43.51) who finished sixth, all swimming great races! Sharbuno (1:18.01) had an awesome race in the 100 Breaststroke out-touching her opponent by only 21 one hundredths, very exciting! McBride (1:37.63) and Cook (2:09.50) also swam the 100 Breaststroke for their team, finishing fifth and sixth places. Ottesen, Klassen, Orvis, and Sharbuno on the 'A' team and Singletary, Pfeifauf, Cook and

Marinez on the 'B' team closed out the evening with the 400 Freestyle relay finishing awesome second and fourth places with their times 4:19.06 and 5:43.21. It has been a crazy week for us, having 2 dual meets and an invite in the last week, but they all are swimming great! I am very proud of all their hard work! The girls are working hard, having fun and bettering their times!

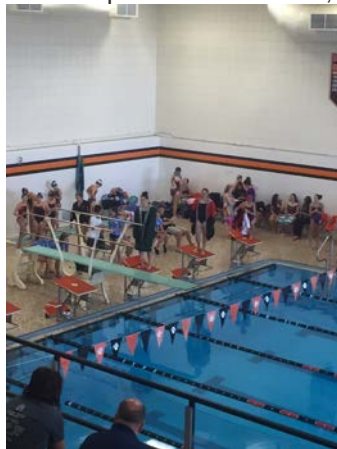

second award podium earning swim was achieved in the 500 Freestyle; Sharbuno swam it in 5:36.99! So exciting and great to see her on the podium twice in a meet!

The 'A' 200 Freestyle relay team: Sharbuno, Orvis, Klassen and Ottesen finished ninth place overall with their season best time, 1:58.07. The 'B' team: Grady, Pfeifauf, a Steig and Singletary also earned Varsity points finishing sixteenth place with their time, 2:15.54! Next up was the 100 Backstroke –Klassen had a great race finishing an exciting fourth place with her personal best time, 1:12.34!

Breaststroke, swum by Singletary (1:32.72) and Ottesen (1:17.18). They both had great races, Singletary finished fifteenth for her team and Ottesen was able to stand on the awards podium for her team with her awesome second place finish!
