Orvis (2:31.97) and McBride (2:39.15 – a 30 second PR!) chose to swim the 200 Freestyle for their team and they both swam great races! Sharbuno (2:26.01) and Klassen (2:49.23 – a 3 second PR!) both swam the 200 IM for their team and it was an exciting race! Sharbuno had an awesome first place finish and Klassen finished fifth place. Orvis (31.53), Grady (32.91 – a PR!) and Cook (36.23 – a 2 second PR!) wanted to swim the 50 Freestyle for their team and it was a great race! They finished third, fourth and fifth places, respectively, for their team and had great times! Sharbuno (1:11.67) and Marinez (1:39.96 – a 3 second PR!) swam the 100 Butterfly for their team and both had great times! Sharbuno finished third place and Marinez finished right behind Sharbuno in fourth place. Hoag was up next for her team swimming the 100 Freestyle.
