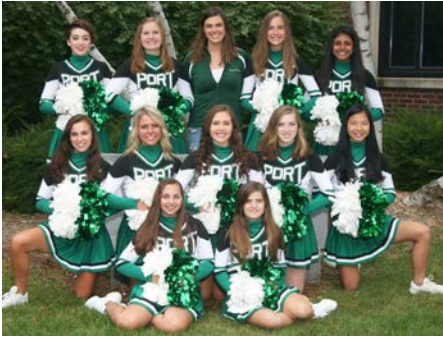

The evening the girls chose to honor their parents in Parent Night, was a dual meet against Grafton. Port's closet rival. The evening began with the 200 Medley relay 'A' team of Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis finishing third place with their time, 2:15.35! The 'B' team: Grady, Singletary, a Steig and Wichmann also had a great fourth place finish with their time, 2:35.44. Next up was Sharbuno (2:06.50 – a best time this season!), Orvis (2:31.57 – a 3 second personal best time!) and Grady (2:32.41) swimming the 200 Freestyle! Sharbuno finished an exciting first place, followed by Orvis finishing fourth place and Grady right behind finishing fifth place. Ottesen (2:31.80 – a 2 second personal best!), McBride (3:00.07), and a Stieg (3:05.19 – a 4 second personal best!) swam the 200 IM finishing an awesome second place for Ottesen, fifth for McBride and sixth for a Stieg. They all had great races! Hoag (51.37 – just a few hundredths off her best time) swam the 50 Freestyle finishing an awesome third place! Klassen (32.50), Singletary (33.19 – personal best!) and Cook (35.43 – one second personal best!) had the opportunity to swim the 50 Freestyle tonight. Klassen finished third place followed by Singletary; who has been

working hard in practice and working to better her time and finished fourth place followed by Cook, who also swam an awesome race and finished fifth place. Orvis (1:26.49 – a 4 second personal best!), and McBride (1:33.50 – an awesome 4 second personal best!) were very excited to swim the 100 Butterfly for their team, both swimming great races and adding points to the team score! Orvis finished an awesome second place, followed by McBride finishing fourth place. Sharbuno swam another exciting event of the evening, her second first place of the night! She won the 100 Freestyle with her time, 58.29 followed by Wichman (1:14.16 – a 2 second personal best!) finishing fifth place and Cook (1:20.33) finishing sixth place. Grady has really grown into a distance swimmer this season, I am not sure she has convinced herself, but she's doing awesome! She finished an awesome third place in the 500 Freestyle with her personal best time, 6:43.21! a Stieg (6:53.61 – a 2 second personal best!) and Pfeifauf (a 22 second time drop and personal best!) also swam the 500 Freestyle this evening and both also had impressive swims finishing fifth and sixth places! Sharbuno, Orvis, Klassen and Ottesen made up the 'A' 200 Freestyle relay finishing an awesome second place with their time, 1:59.04! Cook, Pfeifauf, Hoag and McBride made up the 'B' team also swimming an awesome relay finishing fourth place with their time 2:36.07! It is been awesome watching Klassen swim the 100 Backstroke this season, she continues to work hard in practice and it shows in the meet! She achieved an awesome third place finish with her time, 1:13.13! Wichmann (1:24.31 – 1 second personal best!) was right behind Klassen in the 100 Backstroke finishing fifth place, also adding points to the team score! Ottesen (1:17.01) Singletary (1:33.37) and Pfeifauf (1:41.38)

swam the 100 Breaststroke this evening. All three girls have really been focusing on their strokes in practice and it is exciting to see their hard work paying off in the meet! They all did fantastic, Ottesen had an awesome second place finish, Singletary had a great fifth place finish followed by Pfeifauf at sixth place. The evening concluded with the 400 Freestyle relay 'A' team: Grady, Wichmann, Singletary, and a Stieg swimming an awesome race finishing an exciting third place, with their time 4:59.34! It is always a pleasure to swim against the Grafton team, Port's closest rival; they truly are a great team with the best sportsmanship, they have great talent and sweet girls! We also had the opportunity to see great swims, had great times and most importantly have lots of fun!
