The boys raced well at the NSC Championship and finished in 4<sup>th</sup> place with 115 team points. Homestead ran away with the championship with a low total of only 39 points. Leading the way individually for the 3<sup>rd</sup> race in a roll was Nick Bath. He finished in 9<sup>th</sup> place and earned a spot on the All Conference 2<sup>nd</sup> Team. The top 8 runners earn 1<sup>st</sup> team all conference, runners 9 - 16 earn 2<sup>nd</sup> team, and runners 17 - 24 earn honorable mention. The boys next 3 runners all earned honorable mention honors: Ben Claas finished in 21<sup>st</sup> place, Max Noll 22<sup>nd</sup> place and Brett Grisar in 23<sup>rd</sup> place. Rounding out the scoring was Fraser Toal who finished in 40<sup>th</sup> place. Our last home dual meet, and the celebration of our seniors was against the Warhawks from Germantown. It was a great meet to honor our seniors for all their leadership! The 'A' 200 medley team: Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis began the evening with a third place finish with their time, 2:13.81 followed right behind by the

'B' team: Grady, Singletary, McBride and Wichmann finishing fourth place with their time, 2:36.94. Orvis (2:29.90), Klassen (2:30.52) and Grady (2:30.62 – 1 second PR!) had great swims finishing all very close to each other; fourth, fifth and sixth places in the 200 Freestyle! The 200 IM was a great event for us, we finished second, third and fourth places! Sharbuno (2:27.20) followed by Ottesen (2:32.25) and McBride (3:05.96) all had awesome swims! The 50 Freestyle was also a great race for us, all three swimmers had personal best times! Wichmann (32.18 – a personal best!) finished fourth, a Stieg (32.47 – a personal best!) finished fifth place and Singletary (33.11 – a personal best!) finished sixth! Orvis (1:27.09), a Steig (1:38.13) and Marinez (1:40.83) were all brave enough to swim the 100 Butterfly and all swam great races; finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places! Hoag (1:55.85 – a two second personal best!) was the star last night! Fox 6 News named her their High School Hot Shot of the week! They did a great interview with her on Monday and came back last night for footage of her swimming. It is going to be a great piece on her! We also finished fourth, fifth and sixth places in the 100 Freestyle last night. Cook (1:19.86), Pfeifauf (1:21.46) and Marinez (1:24.55) all swam great races! It has been awhile since Sharbuno swam the 500 Freestyle, and she had an awesome race! I am so proud of her! She dropped 24 seconds on her time!!!! She also finished first, which was an added bonus! Her season best time was 5:29.25! Grady was also able to drop 5 seconds on her 500 Freestyle personal best time, 6:38.18, and finished an awesome fourth place! Right behind her was McBride finishing fifth place with her time, 6:53.50, this was the first time McBride swam the 500 this season, great job! a Steig, Grady, Cook and Wichmann were the 'A' 200 Freestyle team and they had an awesome second place finish with their time, 2:15.68! Followed by the 'B' relay

team: Singletary, Marinez, Pfeifauf, and McBride also swimming an exciting race finishing third place with their time, 2:24.86! Our TV star, Hoag (2:01.50 – a 1 second personal best!) had another awesome race in the 100 Backstroke finishing fourth place! Another first in my coaching career last night, Klassen swam the 100 Backstroke for her team, and she finished with the exact same time she was seeded at! Her personal best time of 1:12.34, she duplicated it last night for an awesome third place finish! Wichmann (1:25.86) and Cook (1:37.07 – a 10 second personal best!) also had awesome races in the 100 Backstroke for their team finishing fifth and sixth places! Ottesen, our number 1 breastroker for the team, has been working hard this season to move her time, and last night she was able to get a season best time! She finished third place in the 100 Breaststroke with her season best time, 1:16.34, followed by Singletary (1:32.68) finishing fifth place and Pfeifauf (1:40.96) finishing sixth place. The final event of the evening, the 400 Freestyle relay, 'A' team: Sharbuno, Klassen, Orvis, and Ottesen had a season best time of 4:18.22 and an exciting third place finish! The 'B' team: a Steig, Cook, Pfeifauf, and Marinez also had a great fourth place finish with their time, 5:21.20! It was an exciting meet, with some awesome swims! A great way to end our dual meets at home and by honoring our seniors for all their leadership and dedication to the team!
