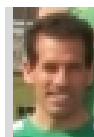
ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

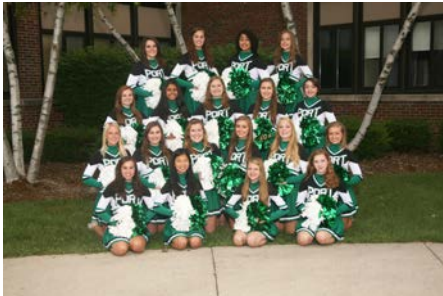

Our dual meet against the Dukes from Whitefish Bay began with Klassen swimming the 200 Freestyle; she finished fourth with her time 2:31.57. Next up was McBride swimming the 200 IM, she too finished fourth place with her time, 3:00.80. Orvis (32.80) Grady (33.26-a best time) and Artamonova (33.86-also a best time) all swam the 50 Freestyle for their team, finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places. Sharbuno scored a first place for her team in the 100 Freestyle with her time, 58.01. Grady (1:11.91-a best time) and McBride (1:14.04) also swam the 100 Freestyle finishing fifth and sixth places.
