Congratulations Karla!



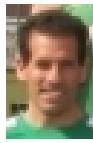

SWIMMING & DIVE by Melissa Hoogester

Our last home meet of the season was also our Parent Night Celebration! A great way to end the dual meet season, honoring the parents for all their hard work and support throughout the season! Our first event, the 200 Medley relay, was swum by: Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Grady on the A relay finishing third place with their time 2:14.50 and Artamonova, McBride, Orvis, and Richlin on the B relay; they finished fourth place with their time 3:03.10 . Klassen (2:26.09) and Grady (2:32.18) swam the 200 Freestyle this evening, finishing third and fourth places. Sharbuno (2:23.58-a three second PR, just missing the school record by 6 one hundredths!) and Ottesen (2:32.12 also a PR by 2 seconds!) went head to head in the 200 IM. Sharbuno came from behind to win the race and Ottesen finished an exciting third place for their team! Orvis (30.81-a two second PR!) and McBride (32.06-a one second PR!) swam the 50 Freestyle, finishing fourth and fifth places. Sharbuno (57.77) Orvis (1:08.53) and Artamonova (1:12.97-a four second PR!) all swam the 100 Freestyle for their team, finishing an exciting first place for Sharbuno, fourth place for Orvis and fifth place for Artamonova! McBride has set a goal for her to swim all the events at least once this season, which she has achieved! Now she has made up her mind to better each one of those times! And she made that goal a reality when she swam the 500 Freestyle this evening and her time was 6:36.58 – an amazing 18 second PR! McBride, Artamonova, Richlin, and Orvis swam the 200 Freestyle

relay finishing third place with their time 2:34.43. Our backstrokers on the team, Klassen and Grady, swam the 100 Backstroke this evening, finishing second for Klassen and fifth for Grady with their times, 1:15.16 and 1:25.26- a PR for Grady! Ottesen has focused on the 100 Breaststroke as her stroke; she and Artamonova swam it this evening. Ottesen finished an exciting second place, just missing the school record by 15 one hundredths! Artamonova, swimming this event for the first time this season, finished fourth place! The last event of the evening was the 400 Freestyle relay swum by: Sharbuno, Klassen, Grady and Ottesen finishing third place with their time, 4:24.99. Our last dual meet of the season was a great success! We had great swims; some of those were just shy of the school records which always make for a fun meet! Lots of fun and the opportunity to honor the parents for all they do for the girls and the team!

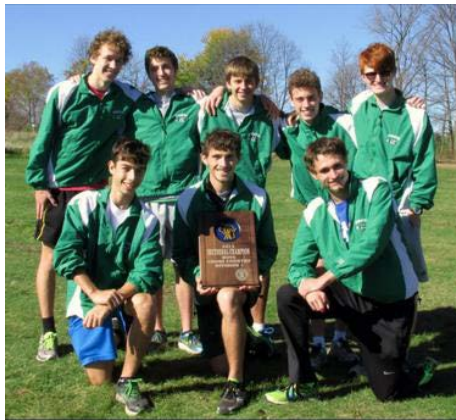


BOYS CROSS COUNTRY

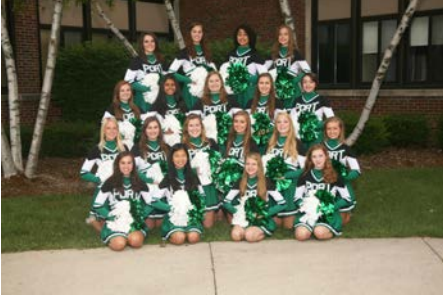

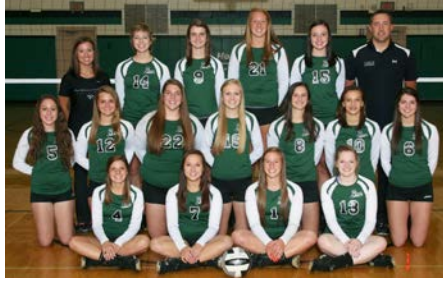
