Our last dual meet of the season, was held at Nicolet high school. The evening began with the 200 Medley relay. Team 'A': Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis finishing third place with their time 2:13.50. The 'B' team: Grady, Singletary, a Steig, and Wichmann finished fifth place with their time 2:36.65. Orvis (2:28.33), a Stieg (2:37.30) and Wichmann (2:39.57 – a 7 second personal best!) all swam the 200 Freestyle. It was a great race, we finished fourth, fifth and sixth places! It has been awhile since Grady swam the 200 IM; she had a great race finishing fourth place with her time 3:08.46 (a 5 second personal best!). Singletary also had a best time in the 200 IM, 3:13.85 (10 second drop!) and finished fifth place. Marinez was the third 200 IM swimmer and she too bettered her time! She dropped 4 seconds on her time, 3:32.73 and finished sixth place. Hoag had an awesome fourth place finish with her 50 Freestyle time 52.03! Sharbuno had an awesome come from behind with in the 50 Freestyle! She finished first place with her season best time, 26.46! Ottesen (27.98) and Klassen (31.35 – a one second best time!) also swam great races in the 50

Freestyle; Ottesen finished fourth and Klassen finished sixth. a Steig (1:35.08 a personal best!) and Marinez (1:43.11) swam the 100 Butterfly for their team, both swam great races finishing fourth and fifth places respectively. The 100 Freestyle was another exciting event for us! Orvis (1:08.07) finished second place, Grady (1:10.44) finished fifth place and Wichmann (1:10.50 – a two second personal best!) finished fifth place! McBride (6:41.81 – 12 second season best!) finished fourth place in the 500 Freestyle. Cook (7:41.03) swam the 500 for her first time this season and she had an awesome race finishing fifth place! And Pfeifauf (8:00.33) also had a great race in the 500 Freestyle finishing sixth place. Grady, Wichmann, Singletary, and McBride finished fourth place in the 200 Freestyle relay with their time 2:16.11 followed by a fifth place finish for a Steig, Cook, Pfeifauf and Marinez with their time 2:22.02. Hoag had another awesome race in the 100 Backstroke; she finished fourth place with her time, 2:00.27! Sharbuno has not swam the 100 Backstroke all season, and I guess last night she was ready! She had an AWESOME race finishing second place with her personal best time of 1:05.95! It was definitely her time to shine! Klassen (1:13.20) and McBride (1:26.43) also had awesome races in the 100 Backstroke finishing fourth and sixth places. Ottesen has been wanting to break 1:15 this season, and last night she did it! She had an AWESOME 100 breaststroke swim finishing third place with her season best time, 1:14.65! Singletary (1:33.52) and Cook (2:03.56 – a 6 second personal best!) also had great 100 Breaststroke races finishing fifth and sixth places! Sharbuno, Orvis, Klassen and Ottesen finished an awesome second place, come from behind race in the 400 Freestyle relay with their time 4:20.34. Cook, Marinez, Pfeifauf, and McBride also swam a great relay finishing fifth place with their time, 5:24.64. It was a great meet and an awesome way to end our dual meet for the

season! We had some awesome times, great finishes and lots of fun!


October 31, 2015 Conference Meet

The Conference meet held at home began with the 200 medley relay team 'A': Grady, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis finishing thirteenth place with their best time, 2:014.16 and the 'B' team: finishing fourteenth place with their time 2:29.51. Orvis (2:21.58 –an awesome 6 second personal best!) and Grady (2:36.15) swam the 200 Freestyle. Hoag (49.11 – a personal best!) swam an awesome 50 Freestyle race! Sharbuno (26.50) finished an exciting award podium eighth place,



Ottesen (27.72 – a PR!) Wichman (31.31 – a PR!), Singletary (31.51 – a 2 second personal best!) a Steig (31.55 – a one second PR!) and McBride (31.83 –a 2 second PR!) all swam the 50 Freestyle. McBride also had an awesome swim the 100 Butterfly, she dropped 6 seconds, and her time was 1:25.99! Marinez also had an awesome swim in the 100 Butterfly, she also dropped time, 5 seconds, and her personal best was 1:34.63! Orvis (1:06.06 – a PR!), a Stieg (1:10.54 – a one second personal best!) and Marinez (1:20.94 – a three second PR!) all swam great races in 100 Freestyle for their team. The 200 Freestyle relay 'A' team: Sharbuno, Orvis, Wichmann and Ottesen swam an exciting ninth place finish with their best time, 1:56.22! The 'B' team:

Grady, a Steig, Singletary, and McBride were just behind them finishing eleventh place with their best time 2:12.92! Hoag (1:54.941 – a 5 second personal best!) had another awesome race in the 100 Backstroke! Sharbuno (1:06.61) had an awesome tenth place finish, Wichmann (1:24.66) and Grady (1:24.66) all in the 100 Backstroke. Our final event of the swim meet 100 Breaststroke, swum by Ottesen (1:14.90), and Singletary (1:31.41). Ottesen had swam an awesome race, finishing eleventh place! It was a great day filled with lots of best times, great swims and plenty of fun!

Nick Bath participated in the Division 1 WIAA State Meet at the Ridges Golf Course in Wisconsin Rapids and finished in 116th place out of the 189 runners in the field. After having a slow start that placed him near the back of the field, Nick did a good job of moving up during the race. He was in 168th place at the mile, then moved up to 148th place at the 2 mile mark and really pushed the last mile and was able to pass 32 more runners. On a wet day that slowed the course down Nick was able to run 1 minute faster than he did at last years state meet. It was a great way to end an outstanding season!

The Pirates finished 3rd at the Division I WIAA Sectional hosted by Homestead at Tendick Park in Saukville. Whitefish Bay won the

sectional with 43 points followed by Germantown with 65 points. Port Washington had 93 points just ahead of Homestead who had 94 points. Wauwatosa East was fifth followed by Menomonee Falls, Nicolet, Wauwatosa West, Cedarburg and Milwaukee King rounding out the top 10.

Abeba Sullivan placed 5th, qualifying her for state in her first year of Cross Country. She was followed by freshman Jill Cavanaugh who placed 18th, Payton Hurley 21st, Alexis Reichardt 23rd and Brenna Kautz 25th in the field of 73 runners. Also running for the Pirates were Clare Goodman 35th and Emma Meyer 45th.

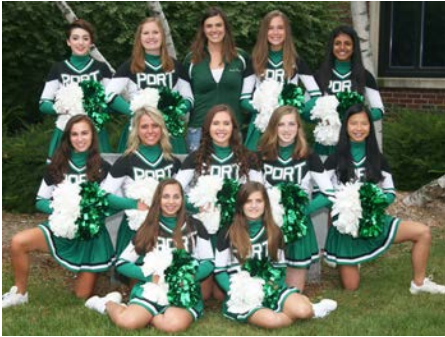
