Our final meet of the season for the Varsity squad, Sectionals, was held at Plymouth High School. The exciting afternoon began with Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis swimming the 200 Medley relay. They finished an exciting ninth place with their best time, 2:09.27. Next up was Grady and Sharbuno swimming the 200 Freestyle. Grady swam a great race and bettered her time by two seconds 2:28.02! Sharbuno came ready to win; and win the event she did! She swam an awesome race winning the event and becoming an automatic State Qualifier with her personal best time, 1:58.29!



Orvis was up next to swim in the 50 Freestyle. She had a great swim and finished in 34.13. The 100 Freestyle was packed with our swimmers! We had Grady (1:09.38 – a two second PR!), Klassen (1:07.35), Orvis (1:10.55), and Ottesen (59.18 – a two second PR!). Ottesen finished thirteenth place with her personal best 100 Freestyle time! They all swam great races! Sharbuno was up next swimming the 500 Freestyle. She finished a second State Qualifying, fourth place, award podium worthy and personal best time, 5:23.91! Sharbuno, Klassen, Grady and Ottesen swam the 200 Freestyle relay for their team eleventh finishing place, with their two second personal best time, 1:55.85. McBride (1:21.17 – a three second PR!), and Klassen (1:16.244) swam the 100 Backstroke, both having great races.



It was Ottesen's turn to shine in the 100 Breaststroke and shine she did! She finished an exciting fourth place finish with her time, 1:16.00. What a great way to end our season for the girls! I am so excited to be taking a swimmer to State; Port hasn't had a swimmer represent them since 2009!
