Hailey Reif

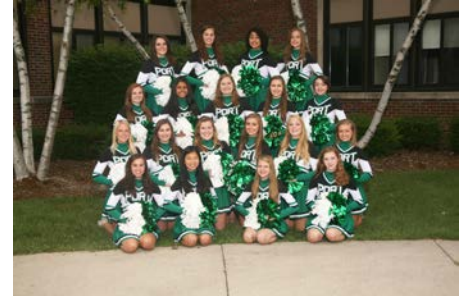

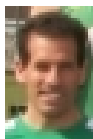

The Conference meet held at Nicolet High School began with the relay team: Klassen, Ottesen, Sharbuno and Orvis finishing seventh place with the best time, 2:09.48. Klassen (2:29.93) and Grady (2:30.38 – a two second PR!) swam the 200 Freestyle. Sharbuno (2:24.45) finishing an award podium worthy eighth place followed by McBride (2:56.15 – a one second PR!) both swam the 200 IM. Ottesen (27.77 – a PR!) Orvis (30.71 – a PR!) and Artamonova (33.55 – a PR!) all swam the 50 Freestyle. Sharbuno (57.03) finishing another award podium worthy fifth place, followed by Orvis (1:07.56 – a one second PR!) and McBride (1:09.16 – a two second PR!) all swam the 100 Freestyle for their team. The 200 Freestyle relay team: Sharbuno, Klassen, Grady and Ottesen swam an exciting seventh place finish with their PR time, 1:57.28! Klassen (1:14.91), Grady (1:22.55 – a three second PR!) and Artamonova (1:28.49 – a two second PR!) swam the 100 Backstroke. Our final event of the swim meet was truly a great ending to the meet and extremely exciting! Ottesen swam the 100 Breaststroke finishing an exciting seventh place and broke the school record! Her record beating time was, 1:13.91! another awesome meet with lots of personal best times and great swims!

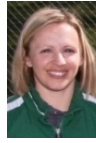

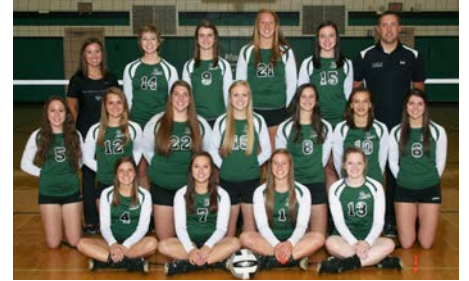
