November 25, 2014 vs Ozaukee

The Port Washington Boy's basketball team opened the 2014-2015 season with a home opener versus the Ozaukee Warriors. The two teams were very evenly matched and the final score would prove that to be true. Ozaukee would jump out to an early lead but the Pirates answered back and the quarter ended with Ozaukee up 11-10. The Pirates turned up the heat defensively in the second quarter and had a few fast break opportunities one led to an alley oop dunk for Tay Jackson assisted by Matt Kirmse. The Pirates would go into the halftime break up 30-23. Continuing the theme of both teams going back and forth the third quarter saw the Warriors outscore the Pirates 17-13. A quick start to the fourth quarter for the home team extended the lead to as many as 10 points but Ozaukee would not go away quietly. With the Pirates up by four points and under 10 seconds to go the strategy was to play solid defense but do not foul. Ozaukee was able to make a tough three point shot to close it to one point. After the timeout the Pirates were able to inbound the ball versus full court pressure and run out the last 1.6 seconds and secure the win 60-59. The Pirates were led in scoring by Al'Tavius Jackson with

16 points, Matthew Kirmse with 15 points, and Patrick McDonald with 12 points. Blake Plier and Ezra Bretl scored 5 a piece and Ben Larson had 4 points. Brad Burbach rounded out the scoring by chipping in 3 points. It was an exciting home opener and the team is looking forward to seeing everyone at the Sheboygan South Holiday Tournament.

November 28, 2014 Sheboygan South Redwing Tournament

The Pirates traveled to the Sheboygan South Redwing tournament with hopes of defending the 2013 title. The first game would have Port Washington matching up with the Eagles of Young Cogs Prep. The game started out at a pretty rapid pace for the Pirates as they were able to jump out to an early first quarter lead of 21-11 led by Tay Jackson's 12 points in the quarter. The Pirates put up another good quarter in the second powered by a trio of Patrick McDonald, Matt Kirmse, and Ezra Bretl doing all the

scoring for the quarter. The score at the half was 41-25 in Port Washington's favor. The Eagles were able to make some things happen in the third quarter on some fast break opportunities but the Pirates would hang in and answer each basket with one of their own. The end of the third and early into the fourth quarter the game got a bit too close for comfort but after a timeout and eleven made free throws the Pirates were able to come away with a 76-65 victory in the semi-final game. Port was led in scoring with a career high of 31 from Al'Tavius Jackson, Matt Kirmse and Patrick McDonald chipped in 19 and 14 points respectively. It was a total team win as 11 players saw action during the game.

November 29, 2014 Sheboygan South Redwing Tournament

In the Sheboygan South Redwing tournament final the Pirates were facing the West Bend East Suns. Both teams were a bit worn down from playing the night before and the first quarter shooting woes for each team reflected on the scoreboard. Port Washington held a slim 7-6 first quarter lead. The second quarter

would prove to be much of the same as both teams were getting good looks at the basket but some tired legs just wouldn't allow the shots to fall in. The Pirates and Suns went into the half all knotted up at 17 points a piece. The third quarter would prove to be no different as both teams were playing pretty good defense and points were tough to come by. The Pirates got a couple of clutch three point baskets from Patrick McDonald and Ezra Bretl in the quarter and that secured a two point lead heading into the final quarter. Motivation for the trophy kicked in for both teams in the fourth quarter as the scoring and intensity started to pick up. The Pirates got a big quarter from Patrick McDonald as he pumped in 10 of his career high 21 points in the quarter. Big baskets by Matt Kirmse and Brad Burbach helped seal the four point win for the Pirates and back to back Sheboygan South Redwing Tournament titles.
