Our first meet and the first on the road was held at Homestead high school on December 2nd.

The evening began with our 'A' medley relay: Nosko, Schanen, LaCosse, and DeMerit finishing an exciting second place with their time 1:59.17 followed by the 'B' medley: Biskobing, Patterson, Noll and Tyree finishing third place with their time 2:14.72. Walch (2:19.47), Hayes (2:39.26), and Biskobing (3:06.78) swam the 200 Freestyle finishing fourth, fifth and sixth places.

Next up was LaCosse (who has returned to the team after spending a year studying abroad in Iceland; we are happy to have him back!) Norman and Locke swimming the 200 IM. LaCosse finished fourth place with his time 2:37.58, Norman finished fifth place with his time 2:59.27 and Locke finished sixth place with his time 3:32.51.

The 50 Freestyle was swum by DeMerit (26.45) finishing fourth place, Schanen (27.92) finishing fifth place and Tyree (28.05) finishing sixth place.

One of the most dreaded races, the 100 Butterfly, was bravely swum by LaCosse (1:08.49) finishing an exciting second place followed by Locke (1:30.59) finishing fifth place. Locke has come leaps and bounds since his freshman year! I am excited to see where he goes this season! DeMerit (1:00.09) finishing fourth, Walch (1:03.61) finishing fifth and Noll (1:04.53) finishing sixth swam the 100 Freestyle.

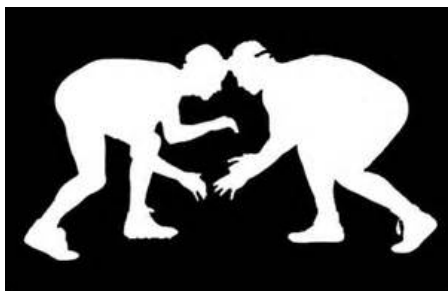
