The Pirates traveled to Sheboygan North on Tuesday night to take on the Runnin Raiders. North would jump out to an early first quarter lead due to some cold shooting from the Pirates which showed the score as 16-6 after one quarter. The second quarter the Pirates started to heat up a bit and string together a couple of defensive stops to put the halftime score at 27-22 in favor of North. The Pirates had a pretty strong showing in the third quarter behind McDonald and Jackson and after three quarters things were all knotted up at 40 a piece. The fourth quarter saw some fatigue set in for both teams as a lot of shots were coming up short. The Pirates were down by two points with less than a minute to go when Blake Plier hit a huge corner three to put the Pirates up by one point. North would then call timeout and the ensuing play they hit a runner in the lane with 11.4 seconds left in the game. The Pirates called a timeout and Sheboygan North had fouls to give before the bonus so they used one to get a clock stoppage. The Pirates ran the same inbounds play but Blake Plier was close lined and lost the ball, Ben Larson scooped it up and shoveled it back to Blake who found Burbach flying to the hoop for a heavily contested layup that would come up just short and time would expire. The second quarter had a burst of scoring from Jackson that would lead the Pirates into a 24-17 halftime score. McDonald came out and set the pace for the Pirates in the third quarter as the lead would balloon to as many as 17 points in the second half. To the Knights credit they didn't quit and were able to storm back on the Pirates and cut the lead to single digits. Some clutch baskets and key stops in the crunch time of the game while also taking care of the basketball under the full court pressure and trapping allowed the Pirates to hang on and secure the 9 point victory. The Pirates were led in scoring by Jackson with 24, McDonald with 14, Brad Burbach with 5, Plier, Haley and Larson all chipped in two points a piece. Ezra Bretl and Brad Burbach turned in some very solid defensive efforts on the night and Brad drew the best charge of the season to date late in the fourth quarter that really kept the momentum away from the Knights. It was a good team win and we hope to see everyone at Cedarburg on Tuesday night.

December 12, 2014 Conference Relays

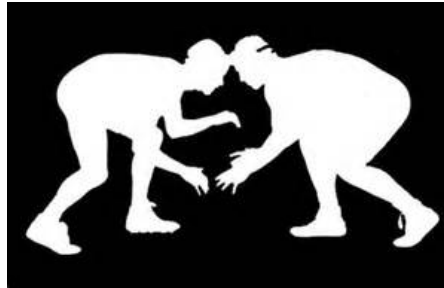
