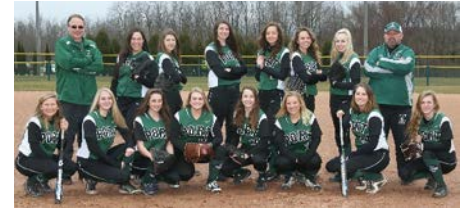
HOMESTEAD: 1
