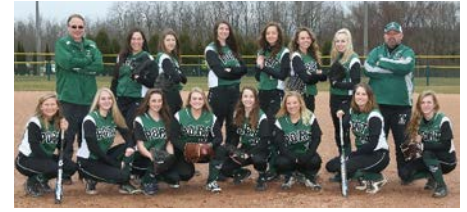

The Pirates finished in 3rd place at the 10th annual Bulldog True Team Invite. We used this meet to get everyone on the team at least one event and to take a final look at some possible roster spots for the conference meet. The meet was won by the host Cedarburg. Some of the top performances were:

Ben Claas winning the 1600 meter run in 4:44.42, Isaac Bensen had a personal best and broke the 5 minute barrier with his 5th place finish in the 1600 meter run in a time of 4:56.06. Zach Wehner also was able to break the 5 minuter barrier with his personal best of 4:58.31, which was good for 7th place in the 1600 meter run.

In the 100 meter dash Deron Spicer and Anthony Masters finished in 6th and 7th place respectively with times of 11.63 and 11.68.

Masters later returned to finish in 6th place in the 200 meter dash with a time of 23.63.

In the 3200 meter run Brett Grisar had a person best time of 10:21.28 which was good for a 4th place finish.

In the 110 meter high Hurdles Nick Landowski ran a 16.83 which was good for a 5th place finish. He also finished in 4th place in the high jump with a leap of 5'10".

In the 300 meter hurdles Nolan Olson finished in 2nd place with a time of 41.41 seconds. In that same event Will Stopczynski finished in 5th place with a time of 44.30 seconds.

The 4 x 100 relay of Nick Landowski, Deron Spicer, Anthony Masters and Nolan Fullington finished in 2nd place with a time of 44.78 seconds.

The 4 x 200 relay of Mitchell Niemeyer, Dylan Niehoff, Austin Sommer and Nathan Russell finished in 4th place with a time of 1:37.58.

The 4 x 400 relay of Charles DeMerit, Isaac Bensen, Zach Wehner, and Zach Miller finished in 6th place with a time of 3:44.25.

The 4 x 800 relay of Isaiah Holland, Brett Grisar, Charles DeMerit and Zach Miller finished in 2nd place with a time of 8:41.78.

In the pole vault Michael Murphy cleared 11'6" which was good enough for a tie for 3rd place. In the same event Sam Fritsch was able to clear 11' which was good for 6th place.

Kyle Casasola had a season's best effort in the discus of 140'02.5" which put him in 2nd place.
