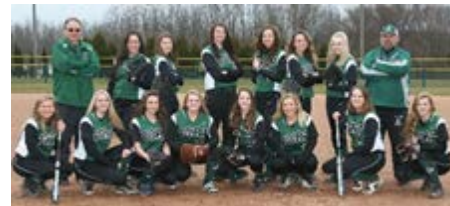

On Thursday 4 athletes earned the right to compete in the WIAA D1 West Bend Sectional Meet. The top 3 finishers in each event advance to the state meet at UW LaCrosse on Friday June 2nd. The day started out with Deron Spicer competing in the 100 meter dash. Unfortunately Deron was not able to overcome a slow start out of the blocks and ended up in 8th place. Next up was Nick Landowski competing in the high jump and long jump which were running concurrently.. Nick who typically clears at least 6 feet and on occasion has cleared 6 feet 2 inches this season was only able to clear 5'10" and ended up in 5th place. The running between two events also affected Nick's long jumping. This is evident in the fact that his 1st jump of the day which was 20'10.25" ended up being his best effort. That was good enough for 3rd place and earned him is first trip to the state meet. Next up for the Pirates was Nolan Olson in the 300 meter hurdles. On paper Nolan was the 3rd fastest runner of the 8 finalist and had a lot of confidence going into the race. After the athlete from Sheboygan South in lane 8 false started and after that the entire field was called back a second time because of an automatic timing issue all of the athletes were on edge. Nolan did a great job of refocusing and was prepared for the 3rd start of the race. He was in a battle with the top 5 finishers for all 300 meters of

the race. In the end he was able to accelerate over the final two hurdles and secure a third place finish. This will be Nolan's first trip to the state meet. The meet ended up for the Pirates with Ben Claas competing in the 3200 meter run. The pace on the first 400 meters was faster than Ben's personal best pace in the 1600 meters. That extremely quick start to the race put Ben into an oxygen debt that he was unable to recover from. He ended up in 7th place and finished his senior season competing at the Sectional Meet for the first time in his high school career.
