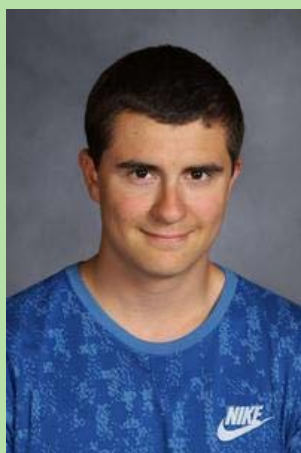

Theis finished an awesome third place earning himself a spot on the awards podium, Kasdorf finished seventh place and Friede right behind finishing eighth place. It was a tremendous way to have our meet start!

The 200 medley team: Miller, Orvis, Biskobing and M. Huebner had a great 13th place finish with their best time, 1:52.69! Biskobing (2:01.56 – two seconds off his best time!) swam a great race in the 200 freestyle! Sharbuno (2:07.57) also had a great 200 freestyle race. Biskobing (57.51– his personal best time!) added some points to our

total with his amazing 6th place finish in the 100 butterfly! He earned himself a spot on the awards podium for his awesome swim! 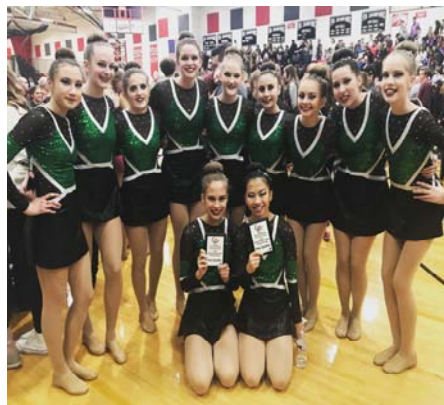

They finished the evening with improving floor routines; Izzi Wickus 8.975, Julia Greisch 7.675, Carmen Hoag 7.425 and Caitlin Hassler 6.95.

On Saturday, we headed to Menomonee Falls for the JV/Varsity Tournament; both teams achieved high team scores for the season-Varsity 126.375 and JV 96.65- they both finished 5th in a field of 9 teams! We started our day on floor, where team scores of 9.325 from Izzi Wickus, 7.4 from Carmen Hoag, 7.375 from Toni Snook, and 7.35 from Julia Greisch were earned. Team bar score included an 8.525 from Izzi Wickus, 7.35 from Caitlin Hassler, 7.15 from Eliana Plier, and 7.00 from McKenzie Rick. Beam contributors were Izzi Wickus 9.05, Carmen Hoag 8.00, Caitlin Hassler 7.675, and Julia Greisch 7.6. Individually, Izzi Wickus earned first place on both beam and floor, fifth on bars, and finished third in the All-Around. Our JV squad continues to make improvements by "leaps" and bounds-Eliana Plier placed eighth on vault, scoring 7.65 and Kenzie Stevens earned third place on floor exercise with a score of 8.20!
