Pirate Athletics Week in Review



BOYS BASKETBALL

The Port Washington boys basketball team opened up the season by hosting the Waukesha South Blackshirts. The Pirates jumped out to a slim lead in the first quarter only to see the visiting team respond back and take a one point advantage at the end of the first quarter 12-11. The see-saw battle continued in the second quarter with both teams trading baskets and getting up and down the floor at a quick pace. The Pirates managed to take a two point lead into halftime. The third quarter saw the Pirates miss some opportunities from close range and Waukesha was able to cash in on some long rebounds to outscore the Pirates 17-11 in the third quarter. With the Pirates being down four points to start the fourth quarter the defense needed to step up and make some plays. The action continued between the two teams back and forth with Sam Weiland hitting a big three pointer and Tay Jackson attacking the rim and drawing fouls. The Pirates found themselves in a four point hole when Brett Kirmse hit a huge three pointer from the corner to close the deficit to one point. After a Port Washington foul and a Waukesha missed free throw the Pirates with no time outs left had to go full court. They had two good looks at shots to take the lead and get the win but unfortunately the rim was unkind and the visitors snuck out with a one point victory. Port was paced with 17 points by Matthew Kirmse in his varsity debut. Sam Weiland chipped in 11 points, and Tay Jackson had 12 points. Pat McDonald and Brett Kirmse rounded out the scoring with 5 a piece.

Sheboygan South Thanksgiving Tournament

The Pirate boys varsity team opened up competition for the 2013 Sheboygan South Redwing Tournament with a rematch from last year with Kenosha Indian Trail. The game was very fast paced due to the full court pressure and trapping defense that Kenosha played. The first quarter score was 11-10 in favor of Kenosha. The Pirates stormed back in the second quarter and scored 20 points and held Kenosha to 9 points. The Pirates headed into halftime with a 10 point advantage. The third quarter saw more fast paced action as both teams were trading baskets back and forth and the Pirates led 44-37 after three quarters. The fourth quarter saw the Pirates re-focus on the defensive end and with a 5 point lead with three minutes to go in the game Kenosha began to use up fouls to stop the clock and put us in the bonus. The varsity boys were up to the task as they went 9 for 10 from the free throw line and secured the 14 point victory. 60-46

The Pirates had a very balanced scoring attack with four players hitting double figures. Tay Jackson led the way with 17 points, Patrick McDonald had 13 points, Matt Kirmse had 11 points, and Sam Weiland chipped in 10 points. Ezra Bretl, Brett Kirmse, and Aidan Wojo rounded out the scoring with 5, 2, and 2 points respectively.

In a rematch from last years Sheboygan Redwing tournament consolation game the Pirates this time were facing Sheboygan South for the 2013 Redwing Championship. The Pirates jumped out early by hitting a few three pointers and handling the Sheboygan full court press. The end of the first quarter had the Pirates with a 21-13 advantage. Sheboygan was mixing up defenses in the second quarter to try and slow down our attack but the Pirate offense was up to the task and also had a great defensive quarter by holding Sheboygan to 9 points in the quarter. We were able to

take 36-22 advantage into halftime. The third quarter was trading baskets back and forth with Sheboygan so they were unable to close the gap on the Pirates. In the fourth quarter the Pirates goal was to run the offense and use up clock and play solid defense. The goal was completed and the Pirates were able to close the game out with a huge 58-41 win. The Redwing tournament championship was a great confidence builder for the boys varsity team this season. All of the players that were suited up for action were able to contribute in some fashion most notably everyone scored at least one basket.
